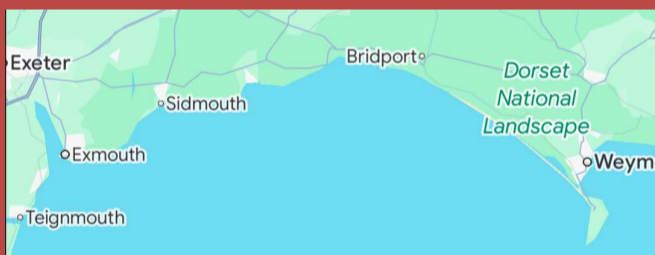


FUNDRAISING Sponsored Sail by Ollie Wilson

Incredible Challenge

- 70 mile sail (the width of Costa Rica at its narrowest point)
- 4m long solo sailing dinghy (Ilca / Laser)
- Around 16-20 hours of sailing over two days
- Navigating many challenges including
 - a dangerous tidal race, around Portland Bill that can be so violent as to make it perilous for even large leisure craft to attempt to pass through it
 - Shipping, fishing buoys and other debris in the water
 - Big waves, tides and the weather

Sail will take place on 17/18th May or 31/1st May / June (the right weather is needed or this is an impossible challenge)
