

Exeter Ship Canal - Convoys and Cranings: Autumn 2017

This year we are again offering a number of Saturday Lock in's through the Canal. Locking in will also be available on some quieter weekdays.

WINTER STORAGE SPECIAL OFFER: Pay a minimum of 6 months storage fees in advance at £66.50 per metre which includes a free lock in/out and convoy up/down on Exeter City Council's organised dates (see below). Spring dates to be confirmed in 2018.

These dates are subject entirely to customer demand and crane availability. You may wish to use an alternative certificated crane company during other times but arrangements will need to be confirmed by the Waterways Office to ensure Council Operatives attend all boat lifts.

It would helpful for us to know your craning plans as soon as possible so that we can provide sufficient staff for the busy Saturday lifts. We also look forward to receiving your locking-in, mast striking and convoy bookings at your earliest convenience.
