Tera (x6)

Where	Where is that?!	What is stored there
Brown box	Attached to the outside of the large wooden shed in the car park.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Rudders/tillers Daggerboards
Boat shed	Where the safety boats live	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Booms (with mainsheets coiled and attached) - racks on left hand wall. Mast and sails - racks on right hand wall Other sails – rolled round big pipes, on the right hand wall. <i>There are 6 Sport sails (with a black leech) and 6 smaller Mini-sails (with an orange leech). If there isn't one of the right size on the mast already, take one off the plastic tube and put it on the mast. Put the one you have taken off the mast onto the plastic tube.</i>
Boat racks by girls changing rooms		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> 6 Tera hulls. Upside down on the racks, tied down. Check there is a bung in there! They have "John Merricks" stickers on the side (careful you don't take a privately owned boat)

Optimist ("Oppie") (x6)

Where	Where is that?!	What is stored there
Boat shed locker	Behind the left hand door, in the large shed where the safety boats live.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Rudders/tillers and Daggerboards – in the cupboard Sail wrapped around mast, sprit and boom. With mainsheet attached. Blocks live ON THE MAINSHEET (not on the boat please!)
Boat racks by girls changing rooms		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> 6 Oppie hulls. They have small "club" stickers on the back. (Careful you don't take a privately owned boat with somebody's name on the sticker instead of saying "CLUB") Upside down on the racks, tied down.

Topper (x6)

Where	Where is that?!	What is stored there
Blue box	Attached to the outside of the large wooden shed in the car park.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Rudders/tillers • Daggerboards
Rig tubes	Long drainpipes, just next to the blue box.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Mast with sail rolled around it and downhaul attached. <i>There are some 4.2 (smaller) and some 5.3 (bigger) sails.</i> • Boom with mainsheet and kicker always attached. • Each tube has one set in it.
Boat racks by girls changing rooms		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 6 Topper hulls. • They are labelled SYC T1... SYC T2 etc (careful you don't take a privately owned boat) • Upside down on the racks, tied down. • Check there is a bung in there!

Fevas – for training or club hire (x2). SYC 5 and SYC 6

Where	Where is that?!	What is stored there
Adjacent to shipping containers, near car park		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 2 Fevas on trolleys, under grey covers. SYC 6 and SYC 6 stickers on their bows. They also have small “club” stickers on the back. (Careful you don’t take a privately owned boat with somebody’s name on the sticker instead of saying “CLUB”) • Check there is a bung in there! <p>In the boats are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Plastic box containing jib and spinnaker. <i>Please dry the spinnaker as much as you can before putting away (maybe hoist on land for a few minutes to allow it to dry)</i> • Blue mainsail • Spinnaker sheets (which stay attached to the boat) • Daggerboard and rudder/tiller • Masthead float <p>In the winter the plastic box and mainsail may live in the junior shed, which is the wooden shed in the car park (at the back, closest shed to the railway line).</p> <p>Please do not hang sails in the junior shed to dry, as the mice eat them!</p>

Fevas - for Junior Racing (x2). SYC 15 and SYC 16

Where	Where is that?!	What is stored there
Junior Shed	Wooden shed in the car park (at the back, closest shed to the railway line).	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Masthead float • Mains – rolled, on the left hand shelves • Jib - rolled, on the left hand shelf. OR in a plastic box on the floor • Spinnaker - in plastic boxes on shed floor. DO NOT USE BLACK ONE UNLESS YOU ARE RACING • <i>Please dry the spinnaker as much as you can before putting away (maybe hoist on land for a few minutes to allow it to dry).</i> • <i>Please do not hang sails in the junior shed to dry, as the mice eat them!</i>
Far north end of the boat park (past the cats)		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 2 Fevas on trolleys, under grey covers. SYC 15 and SYC 16 stickers on their bows. They also have small “club” stickers on the back. (Careful you don’t take a privately owned boat with somebody’s name on the sticker instead of saying “CLUB”) • Check there is a bung in there! • Spinnaker sheets stay on the boat • Daggerboard and rudder/tiller in the boat.
Left hand shipping container	Green shipping container – next to road leading to car park.	<p>REGATTA-ONLY SAILS</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Please DO NOT USE for general club activity, and replace carefully dried/rolled, and not squashed - Main and jib in black sail bags, labelled with sail number 4223 - Two black spinnakers in black bags - Dacron Main sail number 515, (8/10 condition) <p>Also stored here are: White Feva training sails (don’t easily fit mast track); Various RS boat parts; nice Feva cover</p>
